

Anchor Convention Rules & Regulations 2023

1. All Anchors (and Admirals) must have written permission from their parent or guardian. A permission form was enclosed with the registration form. The signed permission form must be given to the Chaperone or Pilot accompanying the club and turned in at the Anchor Registration Desk upon arrival.
2. Each club must be accompanied by a Chaperone (Anchor Advisor (school Sponsor) Pilot Club member, or parent) for each ten (10) Anchors attending.
3. Anchors attending the convention are expected to attend **all** meetings and organized activities.
4. Anchors are expected to act in a responsible and considerate manner at all times.
5. Each Anchor is to stay in his or her group and not leave the convention hotel for any reason without an adult chaperone.
6. Chaperones are responsible for the Anchors in their charge. They should check to see that their charges are prompt and attend all meetings and activities and that they conduct themselves in a responsible and adult manner. Chaperones are also responsible for checking their group to see that the curfew is observed.
7. Anchors are to be in their assigned rooms and quiet by 11:30 p.m. Chaperones will check each room to verify this.
8. Anchors should always keep their room doors locked and not open doors to strangers. Valuable possessions should not be left in the room.
9. Anchors should dress appropriately for each occasion. Anchors shirts and shorts or jeans may be worn Friday evening. Anchors should be dressed in their business casual attire for breakfast and the business meeting Saturday morning. Shorts and jeans can be worn for the afternoon workshops. The evening banquet will be Sunday best attire.
10. Nametags should be worn to all business sessions and workshops.
11. Cell phones and pagers must be turned off during all meetings and organized activities.
12. Candidates for office are requested to sit at designated places for the first session.
13. There will be **NO SMOKING AND NO DRINKING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** by Anchors at the convention. Violators will be sent home.
